and going - But getting awfully stooped.

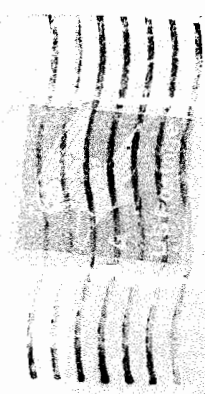
I hope to hear from you soon as to
