

Whereas John Cocks son of John Cocks of Londongrove in y<sup>e</sup> County of Chester in y<sup>e</sup> province of Pennsylvania & Mary Harlan Daughter of Thomas Harlan of y<sup>e</sup> same place having Declared their Intentions of Marriage with each other before several Monthly Meetings of y<sup>e</sup> people called Quakers at New-garden & Londongrove in y<sup>e</sup> County above according to y<sup>e</sup> good order used amongst y<sup>m</sup> & having Consent of parents & friends Concerned their s<sup>d</sup> proposals of Marriage was allowed By y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Meetings

Now these are to Certifie whome it may Concern y<sup>t</sup> for y<sup>e</sup> full accomplishing their s<sup>d</sup> Intentions this Ninth day of y<sup>e</sup> Eight mo<sup>th</sup> in y<sup>e</sup> year of our Lord 1735 They y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> John Cocks & Mary Harlan appeared in a publick assembly of y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> people met to worship God at y<sup>e</sup> Meeting house of New-garden in Chester County afores<sup>d</sup> And y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> John Cocks taking y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Mary Harlan by y<sup>e</sup> hand did in a solemn manner Openly Declare y<sup>t</sup> he took her y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Mary Harlan to be his wife promising with y<sup>e</sup> Lords assistance to be unto her a loving & faithfull husband untill Death should separate y<sup>m</sup> And then & there in y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> assembly y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Mary Harlan did in like manner declare y<sup>t</sup> she took y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> John Cocks to be her husband promising with y<sup>e</sup> Lords assistance to be unto him a faithfull & loving wife untill Death should separate y<sup>m</sup> or in full to y<sup>e</sup> words foregoing: And Moreover they y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> John Cocks & Mary Harlan sh<sup>d</sup> according to y<sup>e</sup> Custom of Marriage assuming y<sup>e</sup> name of her husband as a further Confirmation thereof did then & there to these presents sett their hands: And we whose names are hereunder also subscribed being present at y<sup>e</sup> solemnization of y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Marriage and subscription have as witnesses thereunto sett our hands y<sup>e</sup> day & year above written:
