Andrew J. Cox was the oldest of 10 children. His father was Cornelius Cox, and his mother was Katherine Jackson Cox.

Andrew was born in 1822 in Monroe County, Indiana

His brothers were: Joseph B. Cox; Harvey Cox; Christopher Columbus Cox; George Henry Cox; Jacob Cox and Cornelius Jackson Cox.

His sisters were: Hannah Cox; Elizabeth Cox and Margaret Cox.

They came in a covered wagon from Newton County, Missouri to Texas, arriving in Dallas on April 10, 1845. This was when Texas was "The Republic of Texas". They took up land, 640 acres with the Peters Colony, that bordered the Trinity River.

On September 21, 1861, Andrew J. Cox, his brothers George Henry Cox and Cornelius Jackson Cox rode horseback 90 miles from Dallas to McKinney, Texas to enlist in Col. B. Warren Stone's "I Company", Stone's Regiment, Sixth Texas Calvary. There was a value placed on their horses and rifles, which they furnished.

Jacob Cox enlisted on March 15, 1862 in 18th Regiment, Darnell's Calvary. Christopher Columbus Cox enlisted on March 21, 1862 with Col. N. M. Burford's, 19th Texas Calvary. Harvey Cox enlisted March 21, 1862 in 19th Texas Calvary.

SIXTH TEXAS CAVALRY

The Sixth Texas Cavalry was organized and mustered into Confederate service at Dallas on Sept. 6, 1861. The unit was occasionally known as the Second Texas Cavalry. The regiment had no claim to this numerical designation and it appears that all references to the unit by this name were purely in error.

Information has been found on nine of the regiment's companies. This information is shown below.

Lawrence S. Ross, mentioned above, had been a member of the Texas Rangers prior to the outbreak of the War. He enlisted in the Sixth Texas Cavalry as a private in Sept., 1861. By May, 1862, he had risen through the ranks and was promoted to the rank of Colonel. He was appointed to the rank of Brigadier-General effective Dec. 21, 1863.

The Sixth Texas Cavalry was ordered to Fort Smith, Ark., in late November, 1861. The unit remained west of the Mississippi River until the spring of 1862. 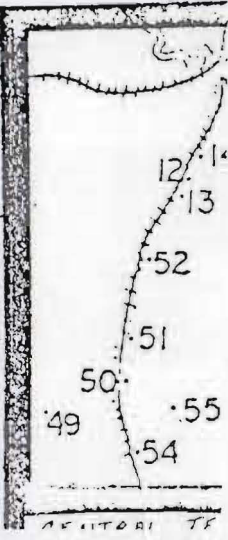
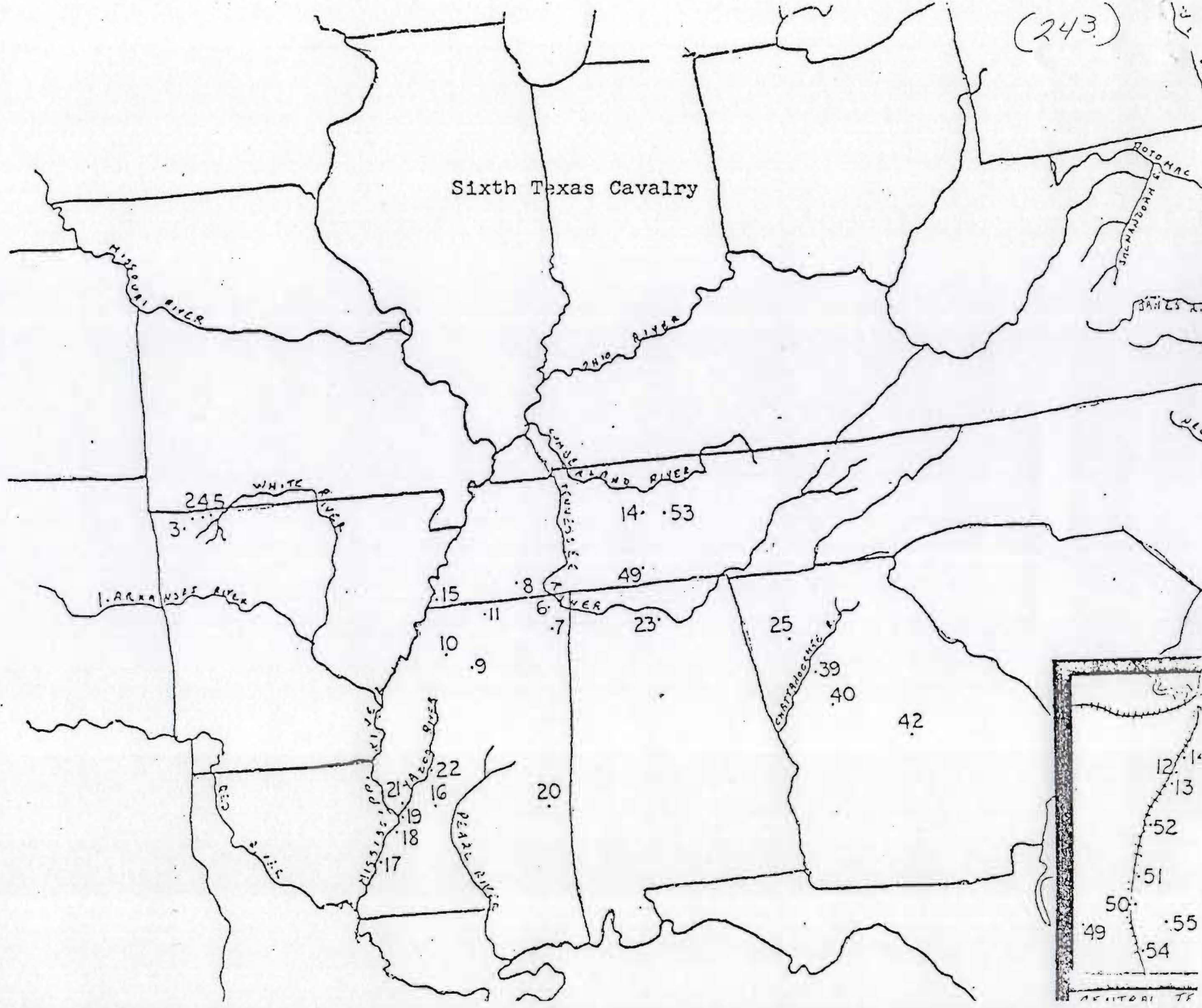

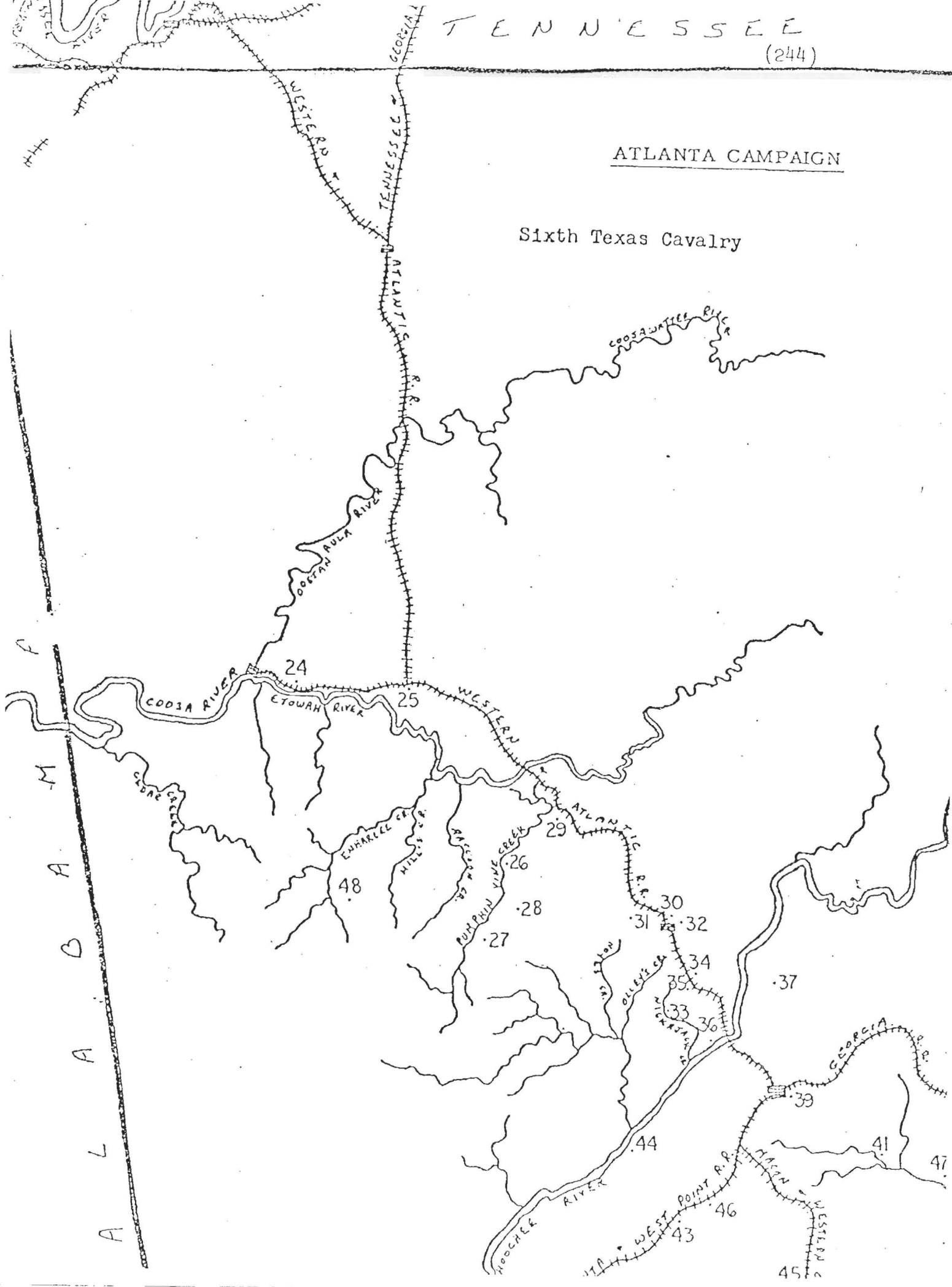
