James Christopher COX - who lived on Lacey Creek for a while Bluff - JAY COX who stayed in Missouri. Thomas COX, an attorney in Arkansas -

⑤ I noticed when I was home Thanksgiving that someone has put a military tombstone on Grandpa Pleasant's grave. He served in the Confederate Army - (Private with the 27th Brigade Texas militia.)

Did he ever talk much about his service in the Civil War? - I was only three years old when he died. I do not remember about that.

⑥ My great grand father J.A. "Hugh" Cox was born on JANUARY 12, 1860 - the year before the Civil War began. Do you know what year or years Grandpa Pleasant served his tour of duty? - I believe it was from 1862 into 1865.

⑦ According to my records you are the oldest son of Francis Marion Cox and Iola Pearl Sims. Did you ~~at~~ have two brothers? One named Joe, the other John? Yes
