6. Do you know what county Pleasant and Martha were married in? I am not sure of the county, but it was near Springfield, Missouri.

7. What was Martha JANE Bibby's parents names? I do not remember their names

8. What was Pleasant C. Cox's parents names? - Father's name was Solomon - I am not sure of Mother's name

⑦ Where were their parents buried?

In Missouri, near Springfield

⑧ Did Martha have any brothers or sisters living in or around Lampasas? Names? One brother Edward Cox. One sister Betsy Huffman. Both moved to Southwest near Leakey, Texas.

⑨ Do you know anyone who might have some good pictures of Pleasant and Martha Cox?

Did Grandpa Pleasant have any brothers or sisters? Yes - AMY, a sister married Brice Smart. They lived near Bertram - There are some descendants of them in that section and FLORIDA.
James Christopher COX - who died on Lucy Creek for a while Blairstown - JAH COX who stayed in Missouri. Thomas COX an attorney in Arkansas.

⑯ I noticed when I was home Thanksgiving that someone has put a military tombstone on Grandpa Pleasant's grave. He served in the Confederate Army - (Private with the 27th Brigade Texas militia.).

Did he ever talk much about his service in the Civil War? - I was only three years old when he died. I do not remember about that.

⑯ My great grandfather J.A. "Hugh" Cox was born on JANUARY 12, 1860 - the year before the Civil War began. Do you know what year or years Grandpa Pleasant served his tour of duty? - I believe it was from 1862 into 1865.

⑰ According to my records you are the oldest son of Francis Marion Cox and Iola Pearl Sims. Did you ~~not~~ have two brothers? One named Joe, the other John? Yes

Also did you have a sister? I have no name for your sister. Only that she might have lived in Massachusetts. [If my records are right, one sister Hattie Cox & her family lived Massachusetts, now lives in Kansas. Another sister lives in Crowley, Texas]

⑯ According to his death certificate, Pleasant Pleasant's middle initial was C. - Pleasant C. Cox. Do you know what the C. stood for?
