involved in the removal of the Christian Indians
from Mississippi as the result of the Seven Point
Treaty about 1832. Strong Coy received
a contract for 300 western horses to be used
in the Christian group. Deibel would show
that Coy and his party delivered these
horses to Chickasaw bluffs and secured
another order for Spanish mules. I hope
to find these records in the Deibel
family records. All of my life I was
told that the eldest Coy man had little
or no respect for either Andrew Jackson
or William Henry Harrison.
