His or his successors we bind ourselves our heirs Executors and Administrators Jointly & severally firmly by these presents seald with or seal & dated this 8th day of November 1794.

The Condission of the above obligation is such that wheos the above Bound Thomas Cox hath this day obtaind a Leusns for his marriage with Rachel Carr Daughter of Maryan Carr. Now if there be no Lawfull Cause to obstruct this marriage then this obligation to be void otherwise to Remain in full force & Virtue.
