to town + did some work on my
house + visited at the nursing
home + visited Elsie + R Q Hill,
I didn't (?)

Sunday 5/5/85

This morning I asked Dad about
the baby buried by Little Moma
in the cemetery. Dad said
Little Moma was pregnant with
him when they lived on Mesquite
Creek + the baby died inside her.
So the 2 doctor Townsends in
Lampasas came out and took the
baby. Little Moma had convulsions
real bad. The baby was a boy.

She was so sick till they moved in
with Grandpa + Grandma Jackson -

(James A + Rachel Caroline Jackson).

5/18/85 D While they lived here Dad worked
for the railroad. Quit because the
work was too hard.

When they left the Jackson's

they moved to the Buford Taylor house at the corner of 580 + Kemper Cemetery Road in Kempner. 1/2 block from the Santa Fe Railroad Tracks in Kempner.

Saturday May 18, 1985

I came out yesterday to spend Friday + Saturday here with Dad while Daddy works some so Momma won't be alone with Dad. I brought Brandy out with me yesterday. And she rassed with Dad + me till around 6⁰⁰. I took her back to Lampasas to Shirley. Then came back out here, to spend the night.

Anyway Saturday noon at dinner table. Daddy + I had got to talking about the end of school when I Mr Jackson would host a end of school party + have horse races. to Butch Woggett's pasture.

The end of school, or during summer around July 4 - maybe - not professional - just country mags + country cowboys.

Before Dad went into the hospital last week (May 6, '85) he was telling me he learned to walk when I

his parents were on a cotton picking binge in Real County a place called Leaky. He took his first steps from Grandpa J.A. Cox and walked to Uncle Jim Cox (J.A. Cox's brother). He learned to walk in the sands - lots & lots of sand. Real County is 1 county (Kinney^{Co}) from the Mexican border. From Kempton to Leaky go to Burnet, Llano, Fredericksburg, Bandera, Leaky, in West Texas.

If Uncle Jim Cox was at Leaky in Real County before 1903 when J.A. Cox took his family there during cotton picking season - is it possible that Uncle Bluford & Uncle Jim, who had disappeared in the 1880's, they went into Old Mexico instead of New Mexico, Arizona, Wyoming, & Washington State as reported?

Saturday May 11, 1985 (written on 5/18/85)

Edith & Tom Sexton, Jackson cousins came tonight, they came to see about Dad. We (Edith & I) opt to talking about the Jackson relations & she has a lot of stuff her mother wrote down & said I can come over any time & read her mother's documents.

Leaky is not far from Uvalde, where the Bybee's settled. Martha Cox's Brothers -
