I am at Shiner today - relaxing and working  
after 5 consecutive days of Radiation

therapy at the Allan Shiner Radiotherapy Center

tact William Hittson - (Witt) Johnston - my old  
friend. Ed Stuckey former County Judge of Leon  
County is now in Beaumont, Texas, being a loyal  
Native of Leon County I felt that he might help  
me re-contact Witt. Ed advised that he knew  
Mr. Johnston some twenty years ago very well but  
that since his mother passed on in 1978 that  
he had not even visited the area since that time.

I am going to visit Barton Stewart of Strawn, Texas  
former Postmaster there and see if I can find some  
of the Hittson family, who might keep in touch  
with Witt.

Hold on to your seat - my brother Joe B. has re-  
tired and has some of the Dotier Collection of books on  
Texas history, lore, what hove you. He knows
