Funeral services for Mrs. Mary Ethel Elizabeth Cox, 76, longtime resident of Kemper, were held Friday at 2 p.m. in Briggs-Gammel Chapel with Minister Reid Schaub officiating. Burial was in the Kemper Cemetery.

Mrs. Cox died Wednesday in Metroplex Hospital after a brief illness.
