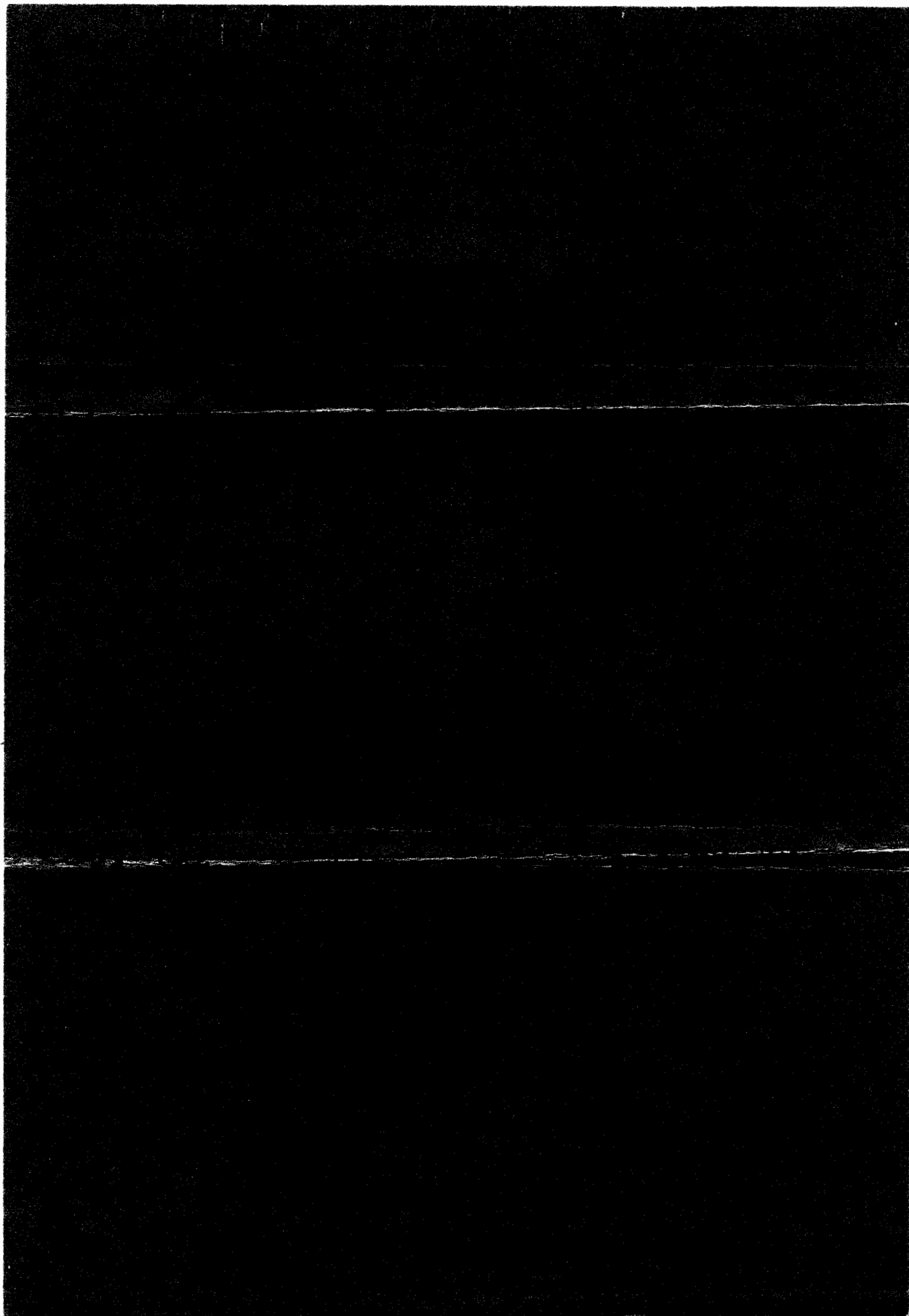


Thursday Feb 10, 1983
