By indenture dated May 12, 1708, "John Garretson of Christee: in the County of New Castle upon Delaware yeoman" sold to "Samuell Silsby of New Castle in the County aforesaid Blacksmith" (for 512) "all that Lott or parcell of Land Scituate lying and being in the Towne of New Castle begining at a Stake Standing by Richard Reynolds Garden ffoure and Runing North Thirty six degrees West one hundred and seventy ifoot to another Stake Standing a little before the said Reynolds Tfoure and from thence North ffifty ffour degrees wast ine hundred and wenty ffoot to another Stalle within the Lotts being a Corner stake belonging to the said John Garretson: other Lotts and from thence by a line Drawne South Thirty six degree Last One hundred and seventy one ffoot to a Stake Standing by Beaver Street thence along Beaver Street South ffifty ffour degrees West one hundred and Twenty ffoot to the first mentioned Stake and place of begining Surveyed and laid out by George Dakeyne Surveyor of the said County of New Castle the Twentieth day of July in the yeare of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and one unto the said John Garretson" by virtue of a warrant from James Logan dated 25th of 4th month (June) "the same year" \* \* "Together with all houses Outhouses Edifices Buildings Barns Orchards Stables Gardens Wayes Waters Improvements \* \* Together with all Deeds Evidences and writeings whatsoever \* \* To have and to hold, the Lottof Land and premises with the apurtenances above granted" and so on. 3
