Removed to Newberry Meeting, York Co., PA 10 Apr. 1738. After the death of Content, John Garretson m. 22 Aug. 1749 to Jane Carson, and in 1768 to Phebe (Elliott) Frazier, widow.

Nathan b. d. 1773, m. ^{1st} 1728 Ann (Cox) Garretson, widow of Casparius Garretson
Heald, m. 2nd 1763 Edith (Way) Webb, dt. of Joseph + Sarah (Pyle) Way, widow of Joseph Webb

John b. d. made apology to Newark MM upon complaint of New Gt. Meeting, on 5 Aug. 1749 for having married about 16 years earlier a woman who was not a Quaker by assistance of a "priest". Her name is thought to have been Margaret Riccord. At least 9 children. After reinstatement in membership, John was granted a certificate to Warrington MM on 2 Sept. 1749.

Removed to Newark MM on certificate from Dover MM, NH, dated 18 May 1723, a travelling minute.
