Dear Mrs. Maples:

I appreciate your kind remarks about the articles,
Legend and Lore of Whitley County.

The basis of the articles are from the earliest court
records. Of course, to make the material more enjoyable, I have
interpolated as to what the officials did or said.

It is true that Samuel Cox II, and Martha, his wife,
were first cousins, and that actually, Samuel Cox, who was one of
the first Court members, was responsible for the County Seat being
established here.

I am not a genealogist, but I am enclosing a bit of
information on the Cox Line-That is the Samuel Cox line. It is
like a puzzle, but starts with Thomas Cox whose will was probated
in London, England in 1711. His children were Thomas, Mary and John.
Samuel Cox I, was the father of Samuel II. Samuel I came from
Pennsylvania to Kentucky, but returned to Pennsylvania and
died there..

Samuel Cox, II, was born in the year of our Lord, 1754.

Samuel Cox, II, about whom we write, departed this life
on the 29th day of July, 1839, aged 76.

His wife, Marthey Cox departed this life March 19, 1845 at 10 minutes
before 2 O' Clock in the afternoon at the age of 84.

I started these articles in October, 1983, and an
article has appeared in The Whitley Republican, Williamsburg, Ky.,
each week except two. I don't have copies of the papers, only
the originals. I am certain that the Newspaper has back copies
and they sell for 25¢ each, and appear weekly..

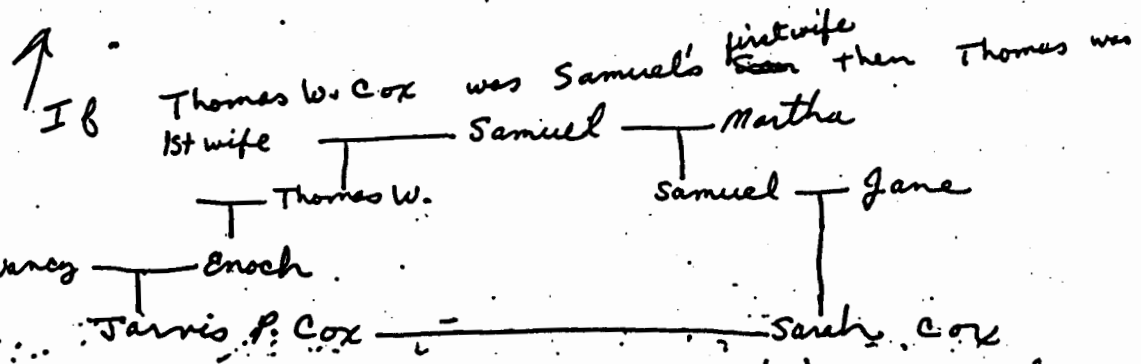
