

According to Mr. Mickan — the Walburg people are socially-church oriented — Each religion has its own cemetery — The Lutherans — old
The Catholics — old
The Lutheran Zion — only since 1890 — all hardcore German settlement.

Weir —

Old Cemetery — dates to 1700's.
Mr. Mickan said his daddy used to talk about the Jackson place its about 2-4 miles from Lutheran Cemetery. He said the old Jackson house burned twice once in the 30's and again in the 40's.
