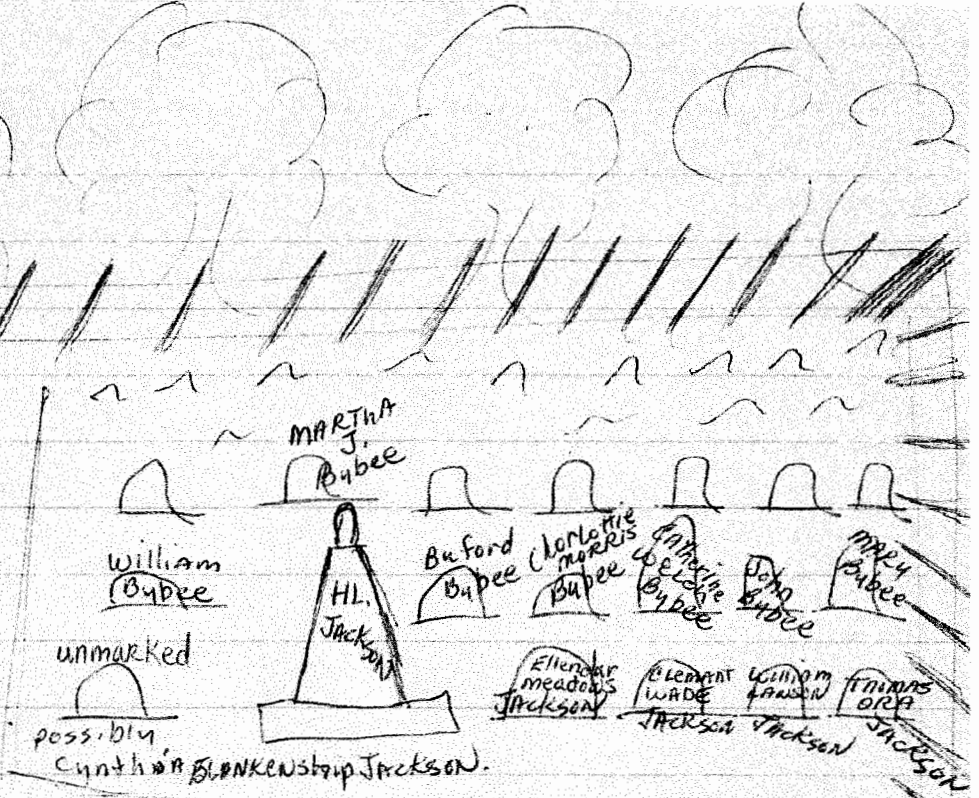

The Lutherans — old

Weir —

Old Cemetery — dates to 1700's,
Mr. Mickan said his daddy
used to talk about the Jackson
place its about 2-4 miles from
Lutheran Cemetery. He said the
old Jackson house burned twice
once in the 30's and again in the
40's.

yet he was polite & helped us
find the Cemetery by the directions
he gave.
